




Bed Making Blues

bed.*




*It takes me

things for you.”*




Which one of my jobs can you do for me, while I make your bed?"

replied Mom.*





“Yes... Oh, then I don't know. There's nothing else for me to do,” said Kay.

it,” said Kay.*




*“I’ve decided that

and faster at it."*






*“Sounds like a good idea,” said Mom.
